



HIGH ROCK RACEWAY

TRACK REGULATIONS

The following Track Regulations are to be observed by all Renters and/or other individuals having access to and/or using High Rock Raceway (the “Track”). High Rock reserves the right at its sole discretion to expel from and/or bar from future access to the Track facility any Renter and/or other individual that fails to observe the Track Regulations. The clothing, safety and other requirements noted below for various types of events are **MINIMUM** requirements:

- ***For auto sessions that exclude racing, where laps are paced and speeds do not exceed 65 mph:***
 - Lap and shoulder belts;
 - Long sleeved shirts and long pants of a natural fiber;
 - Closed-toed shoes;
 - Drivers must be a minimum of 16 years of age and have a valid driver’s license;
 - All minor participants (under 18 years of age) must sign a “Release and Waiver of Liability” designated for minors which must also have a parental or legal guardian signature.

- ***For auto sessions that exclude racing and reach speeds that exceed 65 mph:***
 - Lap and shoulder belts;
 - One piece SFI or FIA rated driver suits with a minimum of two layers are recommended but not required;
 - Closed-toed shoes of leather or Nomex are recommended but not required;
 - Nomex gloves and socks are recommended but not required;
 - Drivers must be a minimum of 16 years of age and have a valid driver’s license and have either a current competition license or proof of completion of an advance run group with a professional school and/or recognized marquee club school;
 - All minor participants (under 18 years of age) must sign a Release and Waiver of Liability designed for minors which must also have a parental or legal guardian signature
 - Snell 95 or newer helmet;
 - Convertibles must have a minimum of a SCCA approved solo one roll bar or a recognizable vintage roll bar. If passengers are allowed in such vehicles, there must be roll bar protection for passengers as well. Convertibles must also have 5 or 6 point harnesses and arm restraints.

- ***For auto racing events:***
 - The group hosting the event must be (or be a member of) a recognized racing sanctioning body (e.g., SCCA, PCA, BMW, NASA, HSR, SVRA, VDCA, VSCCA, etc.);
 - All rules and safety standards are to be enforced as per the sanctioning body’s rules and regulations.

- ***For motorcycle events:***
 - The group hosting the event must be [or be a member of] a recognized racing sanctioning body (e.g., AMA, WERA, CCS, Formula USA, AHRMA, WERA Vintage, FIM, etc.), or agree in



writing to conform to the specific minimum safety standards of one of the aforementioned sanctioning bodies.

➤ ***For karting events:***

- The group hosting the event must be a recognized sanctioning body within the World Karting Association.

➤ ***Additional Track Regulations:***

- The following activities are strictly forbidden anywhere within the Track facility:

***Loud and/or abusive behavior;
Illegal substances;
Fireworks;
Weapons;
Pets (other than trained handicap assistance animals); and
Campfires.***

- Jumping of fences, guardrails, entering areas behind paddock fences or any hot area without first receiving permission from High Rock management is not permitted. Walking onto or across a hot track may result in expulsion from the Facility.
- The speed limit in the paddock is 15 mph. The speed limit on access roads is 25 mph.
- Imbedding of new brakes and/or testing vehicles on infield roads is not permitted.
- Planting stakes or making holes for any reason in any asphalt surface is not permitted.
- Any fuel spill on asphalt surfaces is to be reported to High Rock management immediately. Failure to report such spills may result in permanent damage to asphalt and the offending participant and/or Renter may be responsible for repairs.
- The majority of the paddock area is paved with asphalt. Jackstands are recommended for use on concrete where possible and jackstands are not to be used on asphalt without first inserting a metal or wood protection surface between the jackstand and the asphalt.
- Painting of any asphalt or concrete surface is not permitted.
- Use of the disposal drums in the paddock is required for used oil, antifreeze, brake fluid, and other polluting materials. Emptying fluid into an incorrect drum is not permitted. Participants are to take with them when they exit the Facility all used tires, batteries and unwanted parts.
- Each racing or testing team shall have at least (1) portable dry chemical fire extinguisher with a rating of at least 12 BC available and in good working condition in their pit area.
- Fuel will be for sale at the Facility by credit or debit card only. Four grades of Sunoco fuel will be available: 110 and 112 leaded octane and 104 unleaded octane and an unleaded octane grade of 93 or lower.



- Showers and restrooms are located in the paddock. Please be considerate of your compatriots regarding all water use and do not leave faucets running or be wasteful of water.
- The main Facility gate will typically be open from 7:00 a.m. to 7:00 p.m. unless other prior arrangements have been made. It is the Renter's responsibility to inform its participants and other guests of the Facility hours and to vacate the premises on a timely basis. Should the paddock and premises not be cleared by closing time, the Renter may be billed for overtime of track staff and security.
- Other than with prior written authorization of High Rock, no motorized vehicles are permitted on the track from 5:00 p.m. to 8:00 a.m.
- Participants and/or guests are only allowed to camp within the paddock if arranged by the Renter in advance and the Renter agrees to pay for overnight security at a minimum cost of \$350 per night. Campers will be charged \$20.00 per vehicle per night for paddock camping which includes the use of 110 volt service and \$35.00 per vehicle per night for paddock camping which includes the use of 220 volt service. The number of security personnel required for overnight paddock camping shall be at the sole discretion of High Rock.
- The use of power by Renter participants is included in the Rental Fee. Those using power other than participants during an Event will be charged \$10.00 per day for 110 volt and \$15.00 per day for 220 volt service.
- ATVs, golf carts, pit cars, and bicycles are permitted in the paddock, however, they must be driven/ ridden with care and safety. Children under 16 years of age are not permitted (i) to operate any motorized vehicle, cycle or skateboard within the paddock and (ii) to ride bikes, skateboards, scooters, roller blades or skates in the paddock during hot track hours.
- Renter participants are not permitted to consume alcohol until after their last run session of the day. No glass containers are permitted outside of the concession area and no driving under the influence of alcohol or any illegal substance is permitted.
- Unmuffled engines are not permitted to be running between 10:00 p.m. and 8:00 a.m. A quiet hour is observed on Sundays from 11:00 a.m. until 12:00 noon.
- No loud music is permitted. Please be considerate of others in the paddock area.
- Standing on the pit wall or applying tape to the pit wall is not permitted.
- Smoking is not permitted inside any Facility buildings. Please place all extinguished cigarettes in the receptacles provided.
- All Event food services and/or catering must be arranged through High Rock.
- Without the prior written authorization of High Rock, the Renter and/or its participants and/or guests may not:

***Use any pace or show car during an Event;
Place any advertising within or adjacent to the Facility; or
Film or broadcast any Event.***
